MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Procurement Advisory Notice (PAN) 16-01, Telecommuting for Federal Contractors

1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this memorandum is to establish guidelines regarding telework of Government contractor employees and telecommuting.
2. REFERENCES.
 - a. 41 United States Code 3306(f).
 - b. Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 7.108, Additional Requirements for Telecommuting.
 - c. FAR 11.002, Describing Agency Needs.
 - d. FAR 13.106-2 Evaluation of Quotations or Offers
3. POLICY.
 - a. MRMC shall generally, not discourage a contractor from allowing its employees to telework in the performance of Government contracts.
 - b. Requiring activities shall not include in a solicitation a requirement that prohibits an offeror from permitting its employees to telecommute unless the Contracting Officer (KO) first determines that the requirements of the agency, including security requirements, cannot be met if telecommuting is permitted.
 - c. The KO shall document the determination in writing for prohibiting telecommuting and specify the prohibition in the solicitation. Additionally, the KO shall address the evaluation procedures of the solicitation as it relates to this subject.

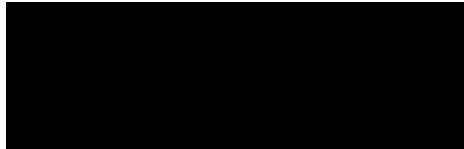

When telecommuting is not prohibited, the Government shall not unfavorably evaluate an offer because it includes telecommuting, unless the KO previously determined in writing that the requirements of the agency, including security requirements, would be adversely impacted if telecommuting is permitted.
